You just have to take a swim to see.

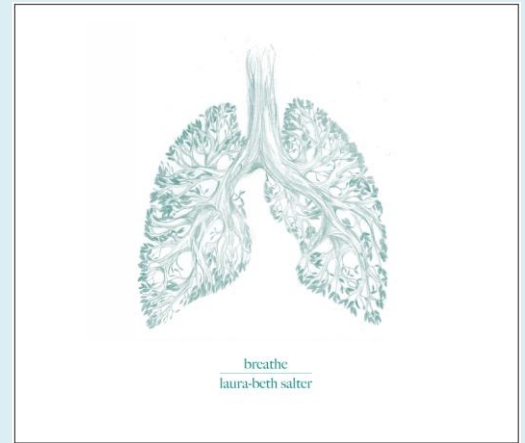
**Big River, take me home
